Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships.

Zonta established the program in 1998 to encourage undergraduate women to enter careers and seek leadership positions in business-related fields. The program ultimately seeks to influence business decisions that positively affect women by increasing the number of women in executive positions in the field of business management. The program was established from a bequest by Jane M. Klausman, a member of the ZC Syracuse, New York. She was the 1990-1995 Zonta International Parliamentarian.

1999-2004: Zonta International offered USD 400 for district recipients and USD 4,000 for five international recipients. In February 2004, the ZI and ZIF Boards undertook a comprehensive review of all of Zonta's programs. Because of that review, some changes were made to the program to increase the value and prestige of the Women in Business Scholarships.

2005-2007: In 2005, Zonta International offered six international scholarships of USD 5,000 each to women in their third or fourth year of undergraduate business study. District awards were no longer offered. Clubs and districts were encouraged to provide their own award at the club and district levels

2008-2009: In 2008, Zonta International began offering twelve international scholarships of US \$5,000 each

2010-2011: Zonta International reintroduced scholarships of US \$1,000 for each qualified district recipient in addition to the 12 International scholarships of USD 5,000 each. The program was also expanded to include women enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a Master's program.

2012-Present: In February 2012, the ZIF and ZI Boards approved increasing the amount of funding for the international scholarship from USD 5,000 to USD 7,000 to the twelve international recipients. Zonta International will continue to offer the USD 1,000 district scholarships

2018 in February: ZI has now increased the district scholarship from US\$ 1000 to US\$ 2000 and the 12 international scholarships from US\$ 7000 to US\$ 8000.
