




Organizational Changes



Women were only 15-16% of Police Officers - now over 20%



Changes: 3% of the Police Officers 60-65 years of age are women but 28% of 20-29 years old.

Violation


 Assaults, sex offences, threats, property damages, extortions, prostitution, human trafficking, child welfare act etc.




Circle of violence





Domestic Violence – Relationships

Violence in close relationships constitutes around 2/3 (68%) of all domestic violence cases

Type of relations	Ratio
Spouse	42%
Former spouse	26%
Child towards parent (regardless of the child's age)	13%
Parent towards child (regardless of the child's age)	9%
Sibling	3%
Someone in close relations towards more than one victim	3%
Someone in close relations other than mentioned above	4%
Total	100%

"Weapons" used

- ✓ "Weapons" were used in 10% of the cases. Knives were most common (1/3 of cases where "weapons" were used), belts, sticks, broomsticks, scissors, candlesticks, cooking pans etc.
- ✓ Other objects used as weapon
- ✓ Bottles, glasses, AC adapter, tongs, cables, wood boards, lamps, spoon, screwdriver, phone, electrical cords, brick, clock of brick, soldering pole, camera, golf club,, fork, dog lease, remote control, laptop,wrench, paper towels rack, toaster, gun, shotgun, craft knive, table, robe from a night gown, iron sheet from a pencil sharpener, cutting board, spray bottle, hot dogs package, jar, stone, shoe, handle of knive, hammer, iron rod, meat, doors, cars
- ✓ And even a bible



Perpetrators – who are they?

- √82% of perpetrators were male
- √76% of perpetrators were Icelandic- but Icelandic people more than 90% of the population
- ✓ Prepatrators were of 55 different nationalities, Polish by far the largest group (1/3) — as in the population in general (Lithuanians, British, Latvians, Thailandese, Philippines, Portuguese)
- √63% of perpetrators were aged 18-40 years
- √51% were under influence of alcohol or drugs and 23% of their victims

Total	757	100%	1318

In 68 % of the ceses involved persons admit prior incidents!!!



Lessons learned

- ✓ Outreach increased awareness of DV in society
- ✓ More cases handled by police as DV
- ✓ Investigations has improved
- ✓ Better evidence gathered
- ✓ More people get help (Woman's shelter, Domestic peace, social services, child welfare)
- ✓ Less repitition?
- ✓ Increased co-operation and trust between police, social services, child walfare and other organizations
- ✓ Number of restraining-orders has risen
- √ The legal framework has changed new Article
- ✓ More cases to court


