Previous to proposing the projects to the Convention body, the International Board has to approve that the proposals presented by the President-Elect can be presented at the Convention.

The members want to know what the results of the International Projects are. Although this is not the work of the UN committee, the participants in the UN workshop want to know. Therefore we can provide this information.

4. The committee will be careful when making information in the future. We will continue to use e-mails via Area Directors /Club Presidents, District 13 website, and also the newly established Face book as channels.
