### NEW LEADER OF UN-WOMEN

United Nations Secretary-General António Guterres, following consultations with Member States and the Executive Board of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women (UN Women), announced today the appointment of Sima Sami Bahous of Jordan as Executive Director of UN Women



Sima Sami Bahous

Ms. Bahous brings to the position over 35 years of leadership experience at the grassroots, national, regional and international levels, coupled with expertise in advancing women empowerment and rights, addressing discrimination and violence, and promoting sustainable socio-economic development towards the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.

Ms. Bahous most recently served as Permanent Representative of Jordan to the United Nations in New York. In addition to multiple positions at the League of Arab States and ministerial posts in Jordan, she has also worked for UNICEF and with a number of United Nations and civil society organizations, and taught development and communication studies at different universities in Jordan.

Ms. Bahous holds a PhD in mass communication and development from Indiana University, United States, a Master of Arts in literature and drama from Essex University, United Kingdom, and a Bachelor of Arts in English literature from Jordan University. She is fluent in Arabic and English, and proficient in French.

# 16 DAYS OF ACTIVISM 25 NOVEMBER — 10 DECEMBER



Annual international campaign that kicks off on 25 November, the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women, and runs until 10 December, Human Rights Day.

It was initiated in 1991 by the first Women's Global Leadership Institute, held by the <u>Center for Women's Global Leadership</u> (CWGL) at <u>Rutgers University</u>.

Since 1991, more than 6,000 organizations from approximately 187 countries have participated in the campaign. The theme for 2021 international Human rights day is "Orange the world: End violence against women NOW!" (LINK).

On 25 November 1960, three sisters from the Dominican Republic were beaten to death and dumped at the bottom of a cliff by President Rafael Trujillo's secret police. The Mirabal sisters, Patria, Minerva and Maria Teresa, who had been activists actively opposed the cruelty and systematic violence of the Trujillo dictatorship, became symbols of the feminist resistance.

In commemoration of their deaths, 25 November was declared International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women in Latin America in 1980.

This international day was formally recognized by the United Nations in 1999.


