Presentation of Keynote Speakers

Razan Haugaard



Razan Haugaard was married at the age of just 13 to a Kurdish freedom fighter and had to leave her hometown in Iraq to live in the Kurdish mountains, where she soon became a mother. Pursued by Saddam Hussein's troops, the family fled first to Iran and then via human smugglers to Europe, and finally to Nykøbing Falster.

In Denmark, a new chapter began for Razan, where she eagerly learned Danish, started her education and began to find her place in society. The challenges with her husband, who could not adapt to a strong and independent wife, led to tensions and later a divorce.

Razan shares her personal journey through marriage and divorce and talks candidly about her time at a shelter and the challenges she faced during a life marked by violence. In her talk, she will delve into topics such as escape, love, betrayal and grief, and how she has had to navigate between two cultures.

Today, Razan uses her rich experience and strength to help other women in difficult life situations, especially immigrant women seeking integration into Danish society. Her work and her ability to use her own experiences to make a difference for others is a source of great joy.
