## CREDIBLE AND VISIBLE VOICE

All Areas have worked diligently for Zonta to be recognized as a credible and visible voice, and you can read more about this in the AD reports.

At District level, we have been the host of a very successful European interdistrict seminar with 343 participants.

Today, the name of Zonta is being heard in Lithuania at the international level. Nearly 100 Zontians are participating in the conference.

# ZI Biennial Goals

## CLUB SUCCESS

In the light of struggling clubs, the District Board allocated 40.000 DKK (approx. 5.300 €) to provide financial support for membership initiatives.

Most clubs have fundraising events, either individually or together with other clubs and many clubs donate to ZI Foundation of Women – this is reported by the Foundation Ambassador.

In Denmark, Zonta is member of the Women's Council Denmark (WCD) and through it also member of the European Women's Lobby (EWL). PIP Maria Jose Landeira Østergård is currently the President of the WCD and has recently been elected as member of the Executive Committee of the EWL and Treasurer of the EWL.

I am humble and honored to be the first Lithuanian Governor of D13.

Lithuania has been member of D13 since 1994, when the Zonta Club of Vilnius was chartered, and having a Lithuanian Governor is a very important milestone for our District.

The journey is not easy, but I am grateful for the support I have received from the strong Board and from all members I have met. Without you we cannot do it!

When I began this journey as Governor, I deeply hoped to see our membership grow. The pandemic, most likely, had a significant negative impact on civic organizations around the world. That's why now I wish for something else – that each of us can be a stepping stone for another.

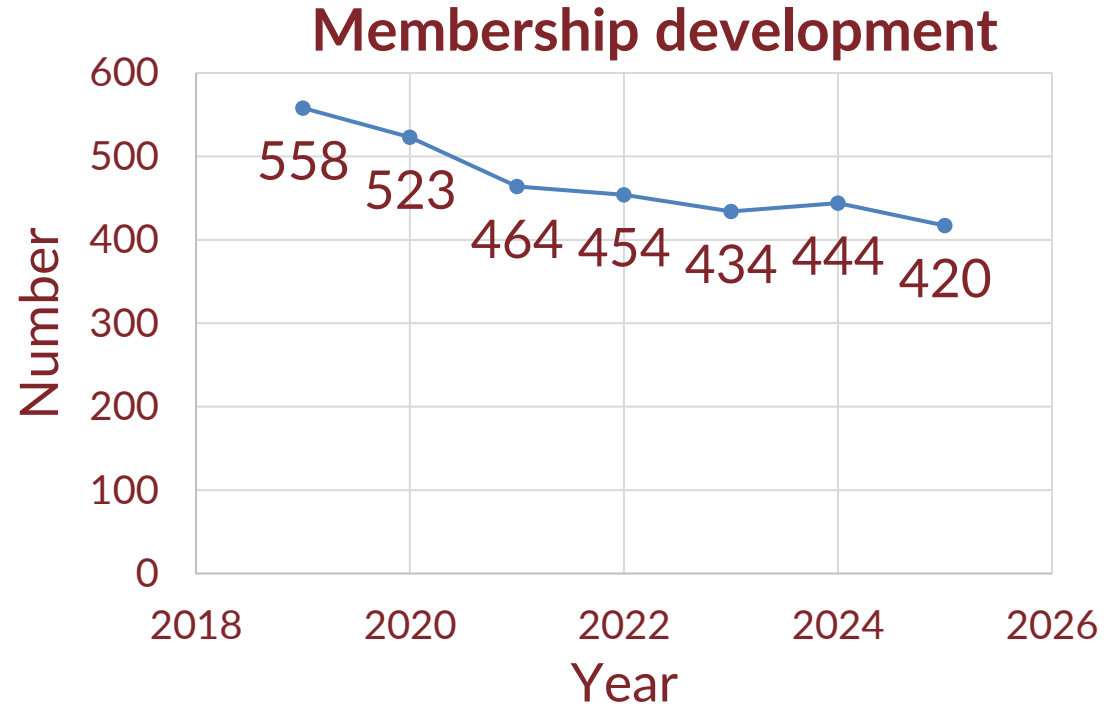

# Projects Zonta Vilnius 2024 - 2026

- Fellowship and support for elderly people in care homes at Adutiškis, which has over 100 elders living there. Club arranged a folk artist- paper cut exhibition and a concert held by famous actress- Virginja Kochanskytė and opera singer- Judita Leitaite. Also was organised charity delivery with different items (books, clothes, household appliances).
- Open to public meeting was organized with book author- club member- Rita Šilenskienė, who wrote a book about anti- inflammatory nutrition and tips how families can benefit from healthy eating skills. Such a meeting was organised in of regional lithuanian school which club sponsors already many years with different support.
- One of most popular events this year- was an event that marked 100th anniversary of actress- Beatričė Kleizaitė Vasaris-who was theater artist, educator, librarian. It was open to public event in Marijampole town, the hall was full of people and Zonta name was widely publicized in the press and news.

# Projects Zonta Alytus 2024 - 2026

Club has organized many events during the year which helped to popularize Zonta name in a society.

- A meeting with book author and gourmet Nida Degutienė, who presented a new book- Flavours of Australia. The event attracted great interest from the town public.
- Club participated in the 100km walk between towns- Vilnius- Alytus, contributing support for autistic children.
- Club has sponsored a student with disability but special talents, school year program was paid from club funds.
- Book donation campaign was organized with club members at town library.
- Together with Rotary and Lions was organized a charity event- "Musical bridges bring us together", during which funds raised were allocated to talented girl master;s scholarship in Switzerland for violin studies.
- Many other projects designed to support young talented children in town, also project to support elders and disabled people.

- Club is known and famous in its town for its continuous charity event each year, called- Kindness gives wings. The last event was attended by children's art groups from Marijampole city. The funds raised were allocated to five talented girls to help them financially improve their talents.
- In order to increase the club's awareness in town, there were established 2 yellow rose gardens in visible city places.
- The club traditionally participates each year in the celebration of the day of Disabled residents of nursing homes with mental disabilities, treating the with home-made cakes.
- Continuous projects with Rotary and Lions clubs organising concerts and events for charity and fund rising to support Ukraine.

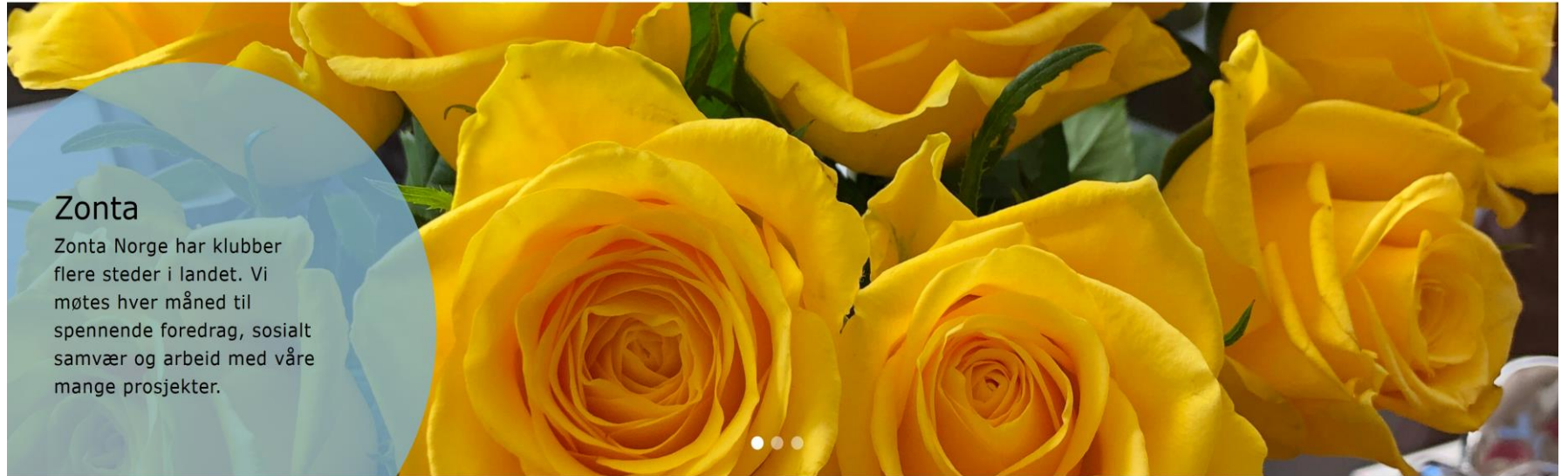

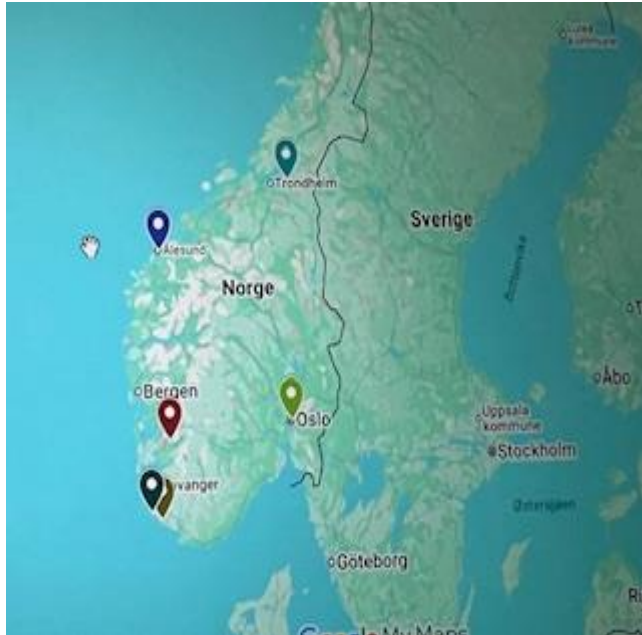

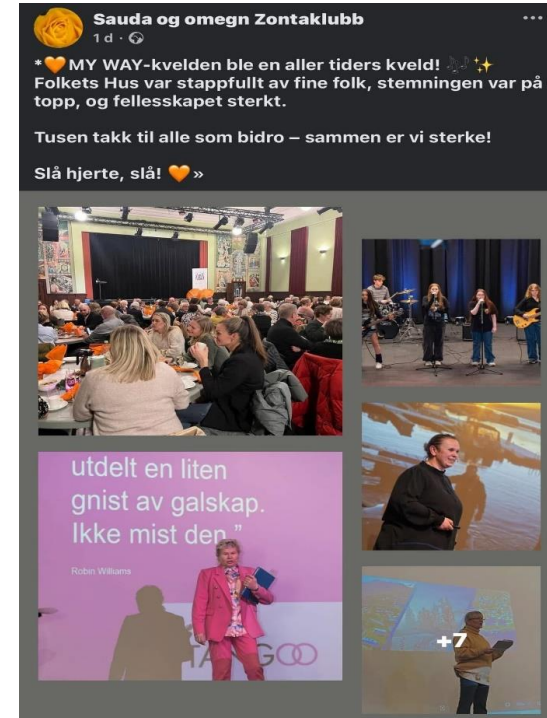
